

Progressive Medical Company History



Progressive Medical, Inc., incorporated in 1986, is an independent organization, privately owned and headquartered in Westerville, OH. Presently, the only subsidiary is Script-Wise, Ltd. Progressive Medical is the sole member of Script-Wise, Ltd. Its Articles of Organization were filed in September 2003. Script-Wise is Progressive Medical's wholly owned Home Delivery Pharmacy program.

Progressive Medical began providing products and services to the workers' compensation industry in 1986 by providing electromedical equipment and medical supplies in the Ohio market.

In 1992, Progressive Medical extended its product line to include a full range of durable medical equipment, laying the groundwork for a nationwide network.

As part of a strategic collaborative effort with one of its clients, in 1996, Progressive Medical developed a Home Delivery Pharmacy program now called Script-Wise.

In 1997, Progressive Medical added ancillary health care services including home health care, infusion therapy, orthotics, prosthetics and respiratory therapy.

By 1998, the Pharmacy program was expanded to be the first fully comprehensive program and included the First Fill®, Retail Drug Card and Instant Activation™ programs.

In 2000, Progressive Medical expanded its services into the auto no-fault and personal injury protection industries.

In 2002, a national network of diagnostic services, transportation and language services were added.

In 2003, Progressive Medical developed IFX, or Information Exchange. The IFX system is a secure Internet tool that not only provides claims professionals the ability to send and receive transactions, the system also provides detailed reporting capabilities.

In 2004, a national network of physical medicine providers was added.

In 2005, Progressive Medical became a provider of Pharmacy Cost Projections for Medicare Set-Asides.

In 2008 Progressive Medical expanded its Clinical Services offerings to include peer-to-peer physician reviews as part of the Intervention RX™ program. The development of IFX 8.0, an enhanced version of the online claims management tool, also took place in 2008.
